



# AQUATIC FACILITIES RULES & REGULATIONS

- Swim diapers are required for all non-toilet trained patrons
- Proper swimming attire is required. cut off shorts, denims, and denim shorts are prohibited in the pool
- Persons showing evidence of any communicable skin disease, inflamed eyes, cold, nasal or ear discharges, or any other communicable disease are prohibited from entering the water
- Persons with the open blisters, cuts or other exposed wounds are prohibited from entering the water
- All flotation devices with the exception of U.S. Coast Guard approved lifejackets. Floaties and pool noodles are prohibited
- Swim fins are prohibited
- Children under 8 years of age must be supervised by a parent or adult at least 18 years of age
- Flotation devices are prohibited on the diving platform and diving board
- Swimming is permitted only when a lifeguard is on duty
- Diving is prohibited from the edge of the pool
- Outside food and drink is prohibited
- Abusive and/or profane language is prohibited
- Public displays of affection are prohibited
- Lifeguards have complete authority; follow their directions at all times
- City of Ada recreation staff and lifeguards may eject and/or deny future entrance to any person for violation of these rules or for any act they deem hazardous to the health and safety of any person, potentially harmful to property, and/or detrimental to order
